Curriculum Integration

Overview:

This multi-year initiative, funded under the Jean Monnet Actions, integrates EU citizenship education across seven curricular subjects (including history, economics, and science) as well as through extracurricular collaborations. It blends traditional lectures with digital tools, peer-to-peer learning, and community engagement involving local NGOs, Europe Direct, and schools.

Description of the practice

This training module is designed to integrate European Union concepts, participation, and active citizenship into educational framework. Blended methodology that combines integration across 7 core subjects: Italian, History, English, Science, Citizenship Education, Economy, and Guidance, that features collaboration with external organizations for practical learning experiences alongside diverse pedagogical approaches. A multifaceted approach ensures students develop both theoretical knowledge and practical skills related to EU citizenship through varied and engaging learning methods.

Teaching methodology

• Flipped classroom, co-teaching, debates, quizzes, interdisciplinary learning, project-based workshops.

Resources and tools used

Digital games, e-learning platform, role-playing games, debates, group works, peer-to-peer activities, videos and apps.

Innovative aspects

- Through co-teaching, subjects are enriched with a European perspective.
- The creation of a didactic module that is open • to the territory, realized in collaboration with other stakeholders.

Target group:

VET students aged 15–18 and teachers

Duration of the activity:

40 hours per year (curricular and extracurricular)

Transferability Tip:

Start small with 1–2 subjects, gradually integrating more teachers and stakeholder collaboration.

EU Focus Areas:

EU Institutions, Civic Participation, EU Values and Principles, Democratic Participation, Sustainable Development and Green EU, Social Inclusion and Equal Rights, Elections in the EU, Cultural Diversity.
